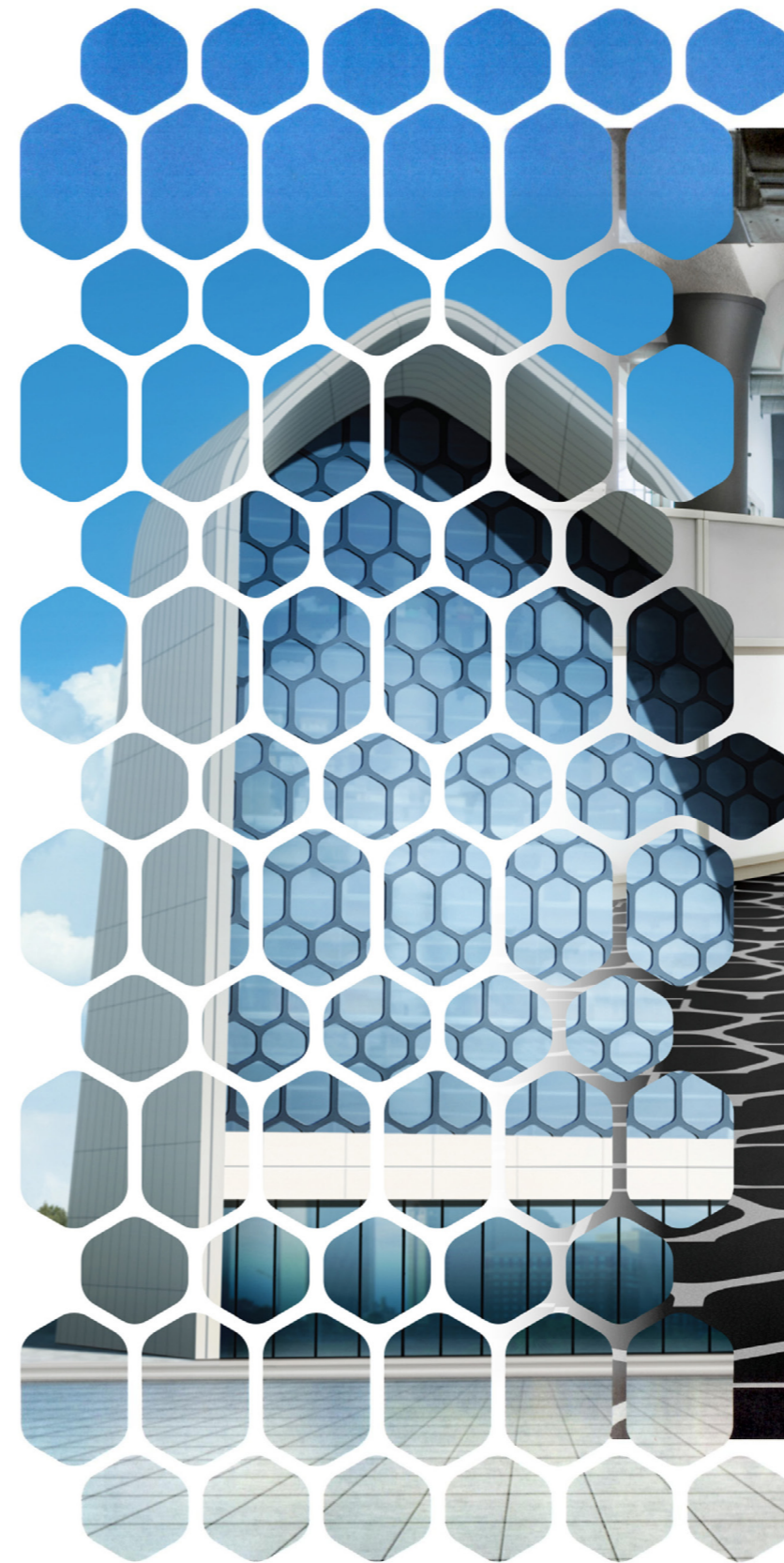
la moda in the mart
